#### We are NOW ACCEPTING **Kindergarten Registrations**

If your son or daughter will be **five** by **December 31, 2024**, he or she is eligible to attend Kindergarten in the fall of 2024.

At that time, you will be asked to provide us with general registration information (Name, Address, Phone Number, Parents' Names, Child's Date of Birth, ...) regarding your son or daughter.

We would very much appreciate it if current George Lee parents would pass on this information about Kindergarten registration to all our families.
