Kindergarten Registrations - Beginning Now

It is hard to believe that we are already beginning to think about Kindergarten for September of 2024. However, before we know it, that first day of Kindergarten will be upon us and new Kindergarten students will be arriving at our doorstep!

If your son or daughter will be **five** by **December 31, 2024**, he or she is eligible to attend Kindergarten in the fall of 2024.

We invite you to call the school at **(306) 791-8510** or drop by to register your child for the fall (September 2024) term. At that time, you will be asked to provide us with general registration information (Name, Address, Phone Number, Parents' Names, Child's Date of Birth, ...) regarding your son or daughter.



Three Way Conferences

We will be using **Sign Up Genius** (no account set up necessary) to book our conferences. Teachers will individually send the link for conferences out to their families. Links have already gone out so please contact your child's teacher if you have not received it.

To sign up for a conference on **Sign Up Genius** with your child/children's teacher/s...

1. Go to the **Sign Up Genius** link electronically provided by the teacher.
2. Once on the teacher's page, click **SIGN UP** and enter your name by the time you would like to conference at.
3. **If you have more than one child you will have to access each teacher's times individually.**

If you sign up for a time and then need it changed, the teacher can change the time for you.
