Kindergarten Registrations - Beginning Now

It is hard to believe that we are already beginning to think about Kindergarten for September of 2024. However, before we know it, that first day of Kindergarten will be upon us and new Kindergarten students will be arriving at our doorstep!

At that time, you will be asked to provide us with general registration information (Name, Address, Phone Number, Parents' Names, Child's Date of Birth. ...) regarding your son or daughter.

1. Go to the Sign Up Genius link electronically provided by the teacher.

2. Once on the teacher's page, click SIGN UP and enter your name by the time you would like to conference at.

3. If you have more than one child you will have to access each teacher's times individually.

If you sign up for a time and then need it changed, the teacher can change the time for you.
